About this piece

Attributed to **Edward William Godwin**, this pair of dining chairs in **oak** aligned to the *Aesthetic Movement* (1860–1890), **c.1880**.

The chairs have carved floret decoration to the headrests, with a rectangular open back above a row of ebonised turned spindles. The front legs are turned and ring-moulded, set on castors, while the rear legs continue upward to form the back uprights. The chair frames are ready for upholstery and sold as a set of two.

The design relates to a comparable example illustrated in Susan Weber Soros*
