### About this piece

This Glasgow School standard lamp, circa 1900, reflects the geometric elegance of the Arts & Crafts Movement in Scotland. The tall tapering frame rises from a tripod base with curved feet, each panel decorated with stylised cut-outs that introduce subtle surface patterning. The upper section supports a simple socket and collar, allowing for a variety of shade fittings.

The combination of vertical emphasis, pierced ornament, and restrained form is typical of Glasgow design at the turn of the century, where influences from the wider Arts & Crafts ethos were reinterpreted through linear proportion and decorative economy.
