About this piece

An **oak side table**, *Glasgow Style*, c.1900. Rectangular form with pierced panels and lower shelf, the stylised cut-outs reflecting early Scottish modernism.

This **oak side table**, designed in the *Glasgow Style* **c.1900**, reflects the emerging Scottish approach to the *Arts and Crafts* aesthetic, distinguished by geometric restraint and stylised linear ornament. The table stands on tapering legs joined by a fixed undershelf, with pierced side panels incorporating sinuous cut-outs that balance structural integrity with decorative form.

Proportioned for occasional or lamp table use, it retains an even surface tone consistent with age and use.
