About this piece

Pair of lampshades in **Vaseline glass**, aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1900**. Compact dome forms with radiating vertical ribs rise to a small fitter opening, above wide flaring skirts with softly ruffled rims that give a distinct profile in antique lighting settings.

The shades function as antique lampshades for period or contemporary fittings, diffusing light through the striped Vaseline glass. Modest proportions suit use as a pair on matching lights or as individual replacements within an antique lighting scheme.

Diameter of a lampshade hole: 2.8 cm/1.10" Inches.
