About this piece

Umbrella and stick stand in oak, aligned to the *Arts & Crafts Movement*, **c.1910**. Elegantly contoured end panels with circular piercings support twin brass division rails that separate canes and umbrellas. The open sides keep the profile light while the fitted drip tray protects floors and makes the piece practical for daily use. Quietly functional and decorative, the form suits a townhouse entrance, country house boot room or compact vestibule.
