### About this piece

A Glasgow School Arts and Crafts oak stickstand attributed to E.A. Taylor with large Ebony and Sycamore chequerboard inlay to the top with turned and slatted struts below and a chrome umbrella/stick holder with 2 central elongated shaped struts and shaped supports to the base with Taylors split heart cut-outs, original drip tray and bun feet. Height 41", Width 13", Depth 8". Circa 1900.
