A good Arts & Crafts oak tub chair with a single pierced teardrop cut-out to the back support and shaped supports beneath the arms. It is unusual for this particular armchair to have twin stretchers which give it a better architectural look, and with no front stretchers it allows more freedom of the legs.

Between the arms inside: 50 cm seat height: 48 cm.
