Probably made by **William Birch**, retailed by **Liberty & Co.**, consisting of two armchairs and two singles, with stylised cut-outs to the head and angular back rests with shaped arms to the carvers and turned legs to the front with ring turned feet.

All of these rush seat chairs have been professionally restored with recently laid new hand woven rush seats.
