A rare Anglo-Japanese walnut and lacquer side cabinet, possibly designed by E.W. Godwin, with Japanese fret work back inset with Japanese lacquer panels, with mirror to the centre and stepped shelve arrangement with upcurved details with conforming Japanese lacquer panels to the doors which also have Japanese style leather embossed panels and further Japanese lacquer panels in red to the drawers and an arrangement of open shelves below with Anglo-Japanese supports and on splayed legs.
