A good quality Aesthetic Movement oak side or cricket table with a circular quarter sawn top gives wonderful figuring to the grain, with a shaped and scroll-carved apron below. Three legs with bulbous carved decoration to the upper legs turning to square section legs united by a triangular lower shelf and stood on square feet.

Garnett & Sons fitted out private and commercial properties, providing chimney pieces, carving and panelling, as well as furniture, upholstery, interior decoration and design work throughout England and Wales. An early *20th-century Warrington trade directory* lists 130 of their commissions which included Bradford Town Hall Council Chamber, Lever Bros' Port Sunlight Offices, the Bishop's Palace at Lincoln, and Osmaston Manor, Derbyshire.

They exhibited at the *Manchester Art Treasures Exhibition* of 1861, and the *Manchester Jubilee Exhibition* of 1887.
