About this piece

By **Liberty & Co**, a pewter casket aligned to the *Arts and Crafts movement (1880–1910)*, **c.1905**. Rectangular body with straight sides and a flat over-sailing lid. The top is set with a square vitreous-enamel panel showing a Pre-Raphaelite-style maiden in profile, rendered in deep blue and green with auburn hair and a white cuff. The pewter is softly planished with fine hammered speckling, and the enamel sits in a neat square rebate that keeps the form crisp and rectilinear. Underside stamped **TUDRIC 0586**. The original hinge has been removed and the rim shortened evenly all around, so the lid now acts as a push-on lid.

Representations of the human figure are quite rare in **Liberty Tudric** pewter wares, particularly Pre-Raphaelite Maidens. Illustrated on page 30 of *Liberty Style* by Mervyn Levy. The enamel is good.
