### About this piece

#### Maple & Co., London

An English Arts and Crafts oak wardrobe with flaring cornice, stylized decorative copperwork hoods above 'A' framed red leaded glass lights with a full-length original beveled mirror door, opening to reveal full-length hanging space inside with a large deep solid oak drawer below, with heart-shaped riveted handles.

The handles are the work of **Richard Rathbone**, one of the best metalworkers of the period.

Wardrobe: Height *7 feet 1 inch*, Depth of cornice *25 inches*, Width of cornice *57 inches*.
