About this piece

Brass planter in the **Margaret Gilmour school**, aligned to the *Arts & Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **late phase c.1900–1910** in character. The body shows a crisp **pressed and chased** scene of a galleon at sea with a rising sun; below runs a repeating band of stylised pods above a separate base ring. A softly **flared, rolled rim** completes the silhouette, motifs and handling consistent with Scottish Arts & Crafts metalwork associated with Gilmour's Glasgow circle. Practical as a cache-pot; use a glass or plastic liner to protect surfaces.
