About this piece

An **ebonised armchair** made by **Oetzmann**, after a design by **E. W. Godwin (1833–1886)**, dating to **c.1885**. The chair exhibits classic **Anglo-Japanese** influence, with spare vertical back posts, aligned structural geometry, and minimal ornament. The turned front supports and rails contrast with gently curved back splats, while a leather-upholstered seat and arm pads are secured with brass studs. The ebonised finish echoes Godwin's preference for dark tonality drawn from Japanese lacquer traditions. Though made by a secondary workshop, the execution reflects the fine proportional discipline and aesthetic restraint emblematic of Godwin's furniture design.
