About this piece

An Arts and Crafts oak hall cupboard

Attributed to Shapland and Petter, with a flaring cornice perfect to pop hats on, an upper bevelled mirror, and an unusual half revolving drawer for gloves and keys inset into the middle of the left-hand door with floral carving to the face of it, decorative floral copper handles and hinges to the door.

The centre upright panel has ebonised and Boxwood chequer and line inlay. The open side features an upper shelf and an umbrella and stick stand compartment with the original drip tray to the base.

The side has a stylish cut-out and an Ivorene registered design label 408 407.
