About this piece

A set of four oak dining chairs designed and produced by **Shapland & Petter (active 1888–1930)**, leading exponents of the **Arts and Crafts Movement**. Each chair features a high arched back with pierced circular motif and vertical slats above a rectangular seat upholstered in green leather. The crisp joinery and restrained decorative detailing typify the firm's balance of craftsmanship and lightness of design. A fine and practical example of English Arts and Crafts furniture from the early 20th century.
