About this piece

By **W. A. S. Benson**, a **brass table lamp** aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1900**. Slender, slightly waisted column with a central knob and a small turned collar beneath the lampholder. Tripod base with **lion paw feet** and a bold **serpent-style tail** that curls upward from one foot; the tail terminates in a **pierced tip** designed so the lamp could be hung on a wall if required. Surfaces show an even brass tone with light age polish. Sold **individually**.
